

MORE SHAKESPEARE OFF THE PAGE: *MEASURE FOR MEASURE*

We'll examine a play that could not be more current: Shakespeare's take on "sexual harassment." Over 400 years ago, *Measure for Measure* dealt with "authority" putting "the make" on a woman. Often called a "problem play," it will surely give us much to think about. "Off the page" means we try to bring the play alive through speech, character, and action. So be prepared to get out of your seats to **do** this play and see what's really on the page. This is not a study in literary criticism. No acting experience necessary.
