

## TWO BY LOUISE ERDRICH

Award-winning author Louise Erdrich has written children's books, nonfiction, poetry, and short stories. She is perhaps best known for her many novels about Ojibway and related Native American tribes in the upper Midwest and Plains states. Characters often appear as minor figures in one novel and reappear as major characters in another. She interweaves families, legends, and customs to form complex, powerful plots and themes. Her characters' stories are compelling, sometimes funny, and often tragic. In this course we will read *The Plague of Doves* and *The Round House*, two novels that are parts of a trilogy which concludes with Erdrich's most recent novel, *LaRose*.
